3. Criminal and corporate responsibility of physician. Physician in the court - rules of testimony.

#### Seminar

1. Legal rules of working as physician. Physicians' duties and rights. Patients' rights.
2. Sources of criminal, civil and corporate responsibility of a physician. The way and basic rules of criminal, civil and corporate trial against a physician. Legal writings, decisions and rulings.
3. Discussion of medical mistake cases in various medical disciplines. The way the mutual and written statements in the court should be delivered. Medical document and its role in the court trial.
4. The duty to save life. The duty to cooperate with legal institutions.
5. Special problems: abortion, procreation, neonaticide, euthanasia, organs transplantation. Drunk physician. Stating the human decease.


